Water Service Agreement - Town of Alpine

By signing below, I understand and agree to the following terms and conditions:

- 1. The property owner(s) are responsible for the cost and installation of the water pipe from the water meter to the dwelling.
- 2. All contractors and subcontractors must obtain a valid Town of Alpine Business License before commencing any work.
- 3. The property owner(s) are responsible for ensuring that all licensed contractors and subcontractors request a water main locate prior to any digging. Requests must be made by calling the Town Office, which will notify Alpine Maintenance or its designee.
- 4. The property owner(s), contractor(s), and subcontractor(s) are responsible for any damage caused to Town of Alpine property or any damage they may incur during the course of the work.
- 5. Failure to schedule and complete a water main locate will result in added liability for the owner(s), contractor(s), or subcontractor(s) and may result in a fine.
- 6. The Town of Alpine requires the owner(s) to install a shut-off valve with a standpipe on the owner's side of the water pit.
- 7. The service line installed from the dwelling to the water pit must be of the same size and diameter as the connection paid for.
- 8. The customer shall install and be responsible for the service line from the existing Town of Alpine curb stop (or inlet of the meter pit) to the building(s) on the property. The Town of Alpine will furnish and maintain the water meter.
- 9. It is highly recommended that a shut-off valve be installed at the point where the service line enters the dwelling.
- 10. If connection to the Town water system is not completed within one (1) year from the date of payment, the application will expire. A new application will be required, and all applicable fees must be paid again.
- 11. If the water meter is located inside the dwelling, the property owner must allow the Town of Alpine reasonable access to inspect, repair, or replace the meter as needed. Refusal to grant access may result in penalties or interruption of water service.

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
