On January 16th, 2018 Mike Hunsaker, Chief Administrative Officer of Star Valley Medical Center addressed the Mayor and Council to explain the Star Valley medical Center's plans for expansion of medical services in Alpine. SVMC's vision is to enlarge the family practice clinic and add urgent care as well as provide a specialty clinic which, to begin with, will be orthopedic services in Alpine. The potential plan is to offer urgent care from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. Monday through Friday and 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Saturday and Sunday.



Mr. Hunsaker thanked the Mayor and Council for leasing the space to SVMC and it is hoped that additional land may be leased to expand the facility. The vision is to tear down the existing clinic and build a new, larger structure.

The Town will sponsor a grant with SVMC as a partner to fund the expansion. The grant will be submitted to the Wyoming Business Council. If the grant process is unsuccessful SVMC Board of Trustees is committed to fund the expansion in Alpine.

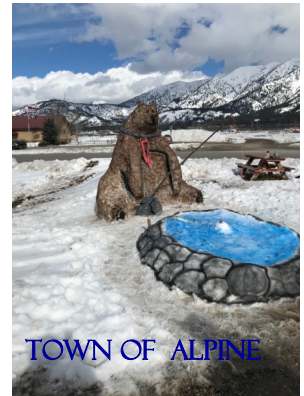
