TREES ON THE HIGHWAY ENHANCEMENT

The Town of Alpine has recently acquired a grant funded through WYDOT for replacement trees along the Highway Enhancement. We replaced 22 missing trees along the roadway that were missing due to weather, vandalism, or disease. We hope these trees will survive and enhance the beauty of our town. Recently you may have noticed town employees have been out trimming trees along the enhancement to make sure businesses are visible from the road.

IMPROVEMENTS AT THE SKATE PARK

The Town of Alpine is in the process of making some improvements at the skate park. The water line has been extended, 22 trees have been planted, the gazebo will be moved and placed with picnic tables and currently under construction is outdoor fitness stations donated and constructed by Jacques Decou. We are hoping to get those placed in the next few weeks.

PARKLET CONTEST

This contest will be between local business's located within the Town of Alpine for providing the best parklet space. A parklet is a space outside a business that provides seating or activity for the public's use. Typically parklets are installed in parking lots or grassy areas in front of a business, some of you already provide such places and this is your chance to enhance it a bit. The concept behind a parklet is interaction with the public with the main goal being to keep residents and visitors in our town longer utilizing our businesses and our community. Elements such as public seating, public art displays, community gardens, interactive game space, etc. These spaces are not required to be permanent. For those of you willing to participate we would like to see the parklets completed by *Friday June 21st* just in time for Mountain Days. Contest winners will be notified by July 1st. Alpine Mountain Days June 21st—23rd 2019







ALPINE COUNCIL MEETINGS Take place the 3rd Tuesday of each month @ 7 p.m. ~ Town Council Chambers 250 River Circle, Alpine, WY.

CREDIT CARDS The Town of Alpine will now be accepting credit cards for all services/licenses/permits. There will be a 3% charge for all payments unrelated to water/sewer.

PLANNING & ZONING MEETINGS Take place the 2nd & 4th Tuesday of each month ~ Town Council Chambers 250 River Circle, Alpine, WY.

BUILDING PERMITS Permits are required within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Alpine. If you are unsure if your project requires a permit please call our office for clarification.

BUSINESS LICENSES are required within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Alpine. Business Licenses are valid from July 1st —June 3oth of each fiscal year. Business Licenses are up for renewal on June 30th 2018. Renewal notices have been sent out for previous license holders.

ANIMAL LICENSES are required in the Town of Alpine. We have received several complaints about dogs roaming the town without owners present for voice command or physical restraint control. Please do not allow your dogs to roam freely through town and be sure to get your pets licensed if you live within the incorporated boundaries of the Town of Alpine.

CLEAN AND ORDERLY PREMISES

Recently we have received several complaints about the maintenance of some properties located within the Town of Alpine. The Town of Alpine does have ordinances that govern the general maintenance of properties located within the incorporated boundaries of Alpine. 
